COMMITTEE ACTION REPORT

On Wednesday, April 27, 2005, the Committee on Financial Services met in open session and considered the following measures:

**H.R. 1768 TO AMEND THE PROVISION OF LAW ESTABLISHING THE Presidential 9/11 Heroes Medals of Valor to make certain technical corrections to carry out the intent of the provision was ordered reported to the House with a favorable recommendation, by a voice vote.**

**H.R. 358 LITTLE ROCK CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL DESEGREGATION 50TH ANNIVERSARY COMMEMORATIVE COIN ACT was ordered reported to the House with a favorable recommendation, with an amendment, by a voice vote.**

The following amendment was considered:

An amendment in the nature of a substitute by Mr. Oxley, No. 1, making various substantive and technical changes to the bill, was AGREED TO by a voice vote.

**H.R. 1185 FEDERAL DEPOSIT INSURANCE REFORM ACT OF 2005 was ordered reported to the House with a favorable recommendation, with an amendment, by a voice vote.**

**H.R. 1224 BUSINESS CHECKING FREEDOM ACT OF 2005 was ordered reported to the House with a favorable recommendation, with an amendment, by a voice vote.**
