

## **Amendment Offered by Mr. Inslee**

### **To the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute Offered by Mr. Oxley**

Page 20, after line 11, insert the following new sub-  
sections:

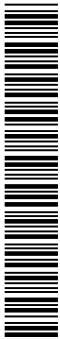

2       (m) SECTION 626.—Section 626(h)(1) of the Fair  
3 Credit Reporting Act (15 U.S.C. 1681u(h)(1)) is amended  
4 by striking “Committee on Banking, Finance and Urban  
5 Affairs” and inserting “Committee on Financial Serv-  
6 ices”.

7       (n) SECTION 627.—Section 627 of the Fair Credit  
8 Reporting Act (15 U.S.C. 1681v) is amended—

9           (1) in subsection (b), by adding at the end the  
10 following new sentence: “For purposes of this sec-  
11 tion, the term ‘supervisory official’ means an officer  
12 not lower than the rank of Deputy Assistant Direc-  
13 tor, or its equivalent, at the headquarters of the  
14 agency or the highest officer in charge at a field of-  
15 fice of the agency.”; and

16           (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-  
17 section:



1       “(f) REPORTS TO THE CONGRESS.—On a semiannual  
2 basis, the head of a Federal agency authorized to conduct  
3 investigations of, or intelligence or counterintelligence ac-  
4 tivities or analysis related to, international terrorism shall  
5 fully inform the Permanent Select Committee on Intel-  
6 ligence and the Committee on Financial Services of the  
7 House of Representatives, and the Select Committee on  
8 Intelligence and the Committee on Banking, Housing, and  
9 Urban Affairs of the Senate concerning all requests made  
10 pursuant to subsections (a).

11       “(g) PAYMENT OF FEES.—A Federal agency author-  
12 ized to conduct investigations of, or intelligence or coun-  
13 terintelligence activities or analysis related to, inter-  
14 national terrorism shall, subject to the availability of ap-  
15 propriations, pay to the consumer reporting agency assem-  
16 bling or providing report or information in accordance  
17 with procedures established under this section a fee for  
18 reimbursement for such costs as are reasonably necessary  
19 and which have been directly incurred in searching, repro-  
20 ducing, or transporting books, papers, records, or other  
21 data required or requested to be produced under this sec-  
22 tion.”.
