RESOLUTION

Requesting the President and directing the Secretary of Homeland Security to provide to the House of Representatives certain documents in their possession relating to the Dubai Ports World acquisition of 6 United States commercial ports leases.

1 *Resolved*, That the President is requested and the
2 Secretary of Homeland Security is directed to provide to
3 the House of Representatives, not later than 14 days after
4 the date of adoption of this resolution—

5 (1) all documents in their possession, including
6 notes from meetings, memos, telephone and elec-
7 tronic mail records, logs and calendars, and records

1 of internal discussions relating to the December 13,
2 2005, document by the Coast Guard Intelligence Co-
3 ordination Center relating to the Dubai Ports World
4 acquisition of 6 United States commercial ports
5 leases;

6 (2) all documents in their possession, including
7 notes from meetings, memos, telephone and elec-
8 tronic mail records, logs and calendars, and records
9 of internal discussions between the White House and
10 Dubai Ports World relating to the Committee on
11 Foreign Investment in the United States review
12 process for such acquisition; and

13 (3) all documents in their possession, including
14 notes from meetings, memos, telephone and elec-
15 tronic mail records, logs and calendars, and records
16 of internal discussions between the White House and
17 the Carlyle Group during the period beginning Octo-
18 ber 1, 2005, and ending March 2, 2006, relating to
19 the Committee on Foreign Investment in the United
20 States review process for such acquisition.
